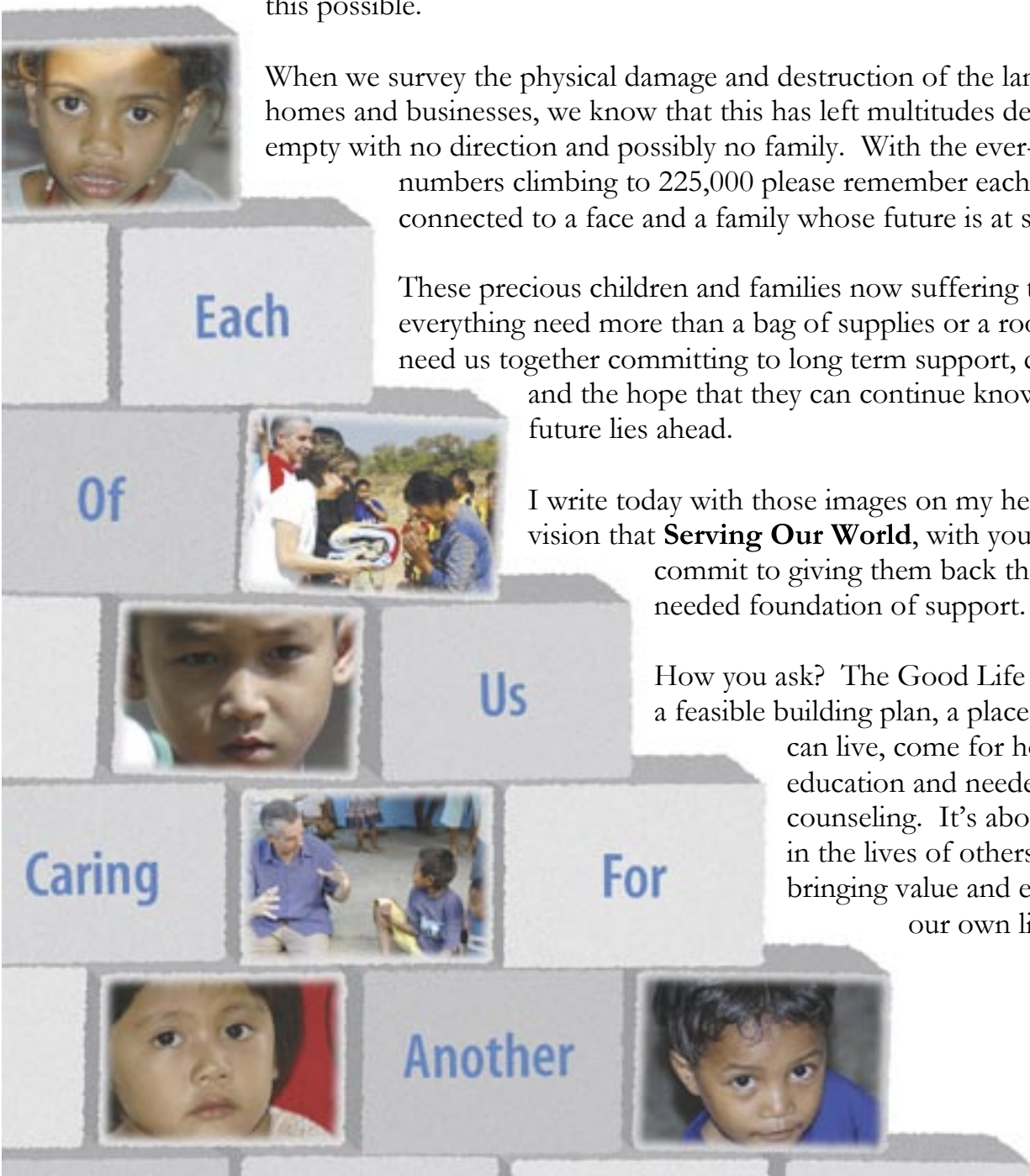
We are right now bringing in supplies and building homes for those affected by this devastating wave. Thanks to you for your generous donations, which make this possible.
